PERFORMANCE SHIRTS

All dancers in Pre-Ballet, Primary, Ballet level 1 and 2 will receive a shirt to commemorate their participation.

WHAT TO BRING ON RECITAL DAY?

What should your dancer have on hand during the recital? We've got a quick list of items to help make this special day fun and stress-free! Please note that snacks are not allowed in the Donnie Williams Center. In addition to your dancer's costume(s) and accessories, you may want to pack:

- Ballet, jazz, or tap shoes
- Cover-up for entering/exiting
- Extra pair of tights
- Water bottle
- Extra masks
- Hair brush, pins, elastics and a hair net
- Hairspray or hair gel to keep wispsies in place
- A flesh colored undergarment for costume changes
- Make-up in case a touch up is needed
- Make-up wipes
- Safety pins
- Band aids
- Hand sanitizer
- Book or other quiet entertainment
