Known as "supers," supernumeraries are extra dancers of the ballet world that enhance and create a believable scene. These dancers are chosen from our students participating in the May Recital. They will enjoy extra stage time participating in the June Performance and delight in the aspect of appearing with the advanced dancers. Dancers are chosen based on a number of factors including the following: dance ability, maturity, as well as ability to follow instruction and remain focused.
